

The 8th Epsilon Fund Award to Top Students

The Epsilon Fund Award was established in 2006 with donations from faculty and staff at the Department of Mathematics, or from the departmental fund to honor excellent students, including undergraduates, postgraduates and post-doctoral researchers who excel in mathematical scholarship and research. More than forty students were awarded since its establishment. This year seven students get the award. Each of them possesses very high cumulative grade average, especially in mathematics subject, and some have received multiple graduate program offers from famous universities.

1. Anqi Angela WU (Year 2; MPhil)

Angela Anqi WU came first as our undergraduate student in 2008. She selected the Pure Mathematics-Advanced Stream program and received a first class honor at graduation in 2011. Angela later continued her MPhil study in the Mathematics Department. Her academic results stay outstanding. Her research supervisor (Professor YC Zhu) said, "In her MPhil thesis, Angela Wu studied three apparently different infinite dimensional Hopf algebras, each labelled by a complex number q . The three algebras are natural Hopf algebras. The first is related to the symmetric polynomials, the second is a q -deformation of the universal enveloping algebra of a free Lie algebra, the third is a q -deformation of the shuffle algebra. Angela's main result is that for q not in certain subset of algebraic numbers, the three Hopf algebras are isomorphic. Angela uses the techniques in symmetric groups and diagram presentations to prove the result". Angela has been awarded several academic scholarships: the University Scholarship, the HKSAR Government Scholarship, So Hok Scholarship, Li & Fung Scholarship, Academic Achievement Medal. She gets admitted to UCLA and will do a PhD in Mathematics there.


